Honors Courses

Honors Credit in a Regular Course

Honors Scholars are encouraged to undertake honors-level work in any appropriate course. Honors work normally involves substantial independent research and/or projects in addition to the normal requirements of the course. Specific expectations for contract honors credit must be negotiated between the student and professor and approved by both the department chairperson and the Honors Scholars Program Director. Honors credit is noted on the transcript as "Honors Project" followed by the course and semester. The Contract for Honors Credit in a Regular Course should be completed and signed by the student and professor as soon as possible. The original contract needs to be submitted six weeks after the first day of class to the Honors Scholars Program office (Midway 308).
